PUBLIC NOTICE

To Provide comments/ suggestions/objections on conversion of single point connection into individual connections in a Co-operative Group Housing Society (CGHS)

- The Commission received various requests from CGHS for conversion of single point connection into individual connection. The Commission proposes to convert single point connection at the CGHS into individual connection based on the following:-

- (i.) The existing complete distribution system within the CGHS shall be handed over to the distribution licensee without any monetary compensation.
- (ii.) The additional expenditure, if required shall be borne by the distribution licensee considering the handing over of existing distribution network as 50% of the notional funding required from CGHS.
- (iii.) CGHS shall provide adequate space, if required at convenient place for installing the transformers, allied equipment and meters by the licensee at no cost.
- (iv.) The licensee shall not be required to provide electrical distribution arrangements for stand by supply such as Diesel Generator (DG) set.
- (v.) Each member shall apply for direct supply of electricity from distribution licensee individually and shall pay required security deposit and 50% of applicable SLD charges at the time of conversion.
- (vi.) CGHS shall apply for separate connection for common services.

2. In case all the members are not desirous to avail direct supply of electricity from distribution licensee, 50% cost required for providing connection shall be borne by the applicants in the ratio of the sanctioned load of such applicants with a consent from CGHS for providing adequate space, if required at convenient place for installing the transformers, allied equipment, underground cables, meters etc by the distribution licensee at no cost. Security deposit shall also be payable as per prevailing rates at the time of taking direct supply from the distribution licensee.

3. Stakeholders are requested to forward their comments/suggestions/objections on the above procedure latest by 1.6.2016. The comments/suggestions/objections may be forwarded to Secretary, DERC either by post or through email to secyderc@nic.in.
