## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

### **EXTENSION OF LAST DATE FOR RECEIPT OF COMMENTS ON DRAFT DERC (TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR DETERMINATION OF TARIFF FOR PROCUREMENT OF POWER FROM GRID-CONNECTED SOLAR PHOTO VOLTIC POWER PROJECTS) AND DRAFT DERC (DSM IMPLEMENTATION FRAMEWORK) REGULATIONS, 2012.**

1. The Commission had published a Public Notice on 02.03.2012 and 01.03.2012 seeking comments from all the stakeholders on Draft DERC (Terms & Conditions for determination of tariff for procurement of power from Grid-Connected Solar Photo Voltaic Power Projects) and Draft DERC (DSM Implementation Framework) Regulations, 2012 respectively. The last date for receipt of comments from stakeholders was 19.03.2012 and 16.03.2012 respectively.
2. **At the request of the various stakeholders, the Commission has decided to extend the last date for receipt of comments/objections till 30.03.2012 for both the Regulations.**
3. The draft Regulations along with the Staff Paper may be downloaded from the website of the Commission i.e. [www.derc.gov.in](http://www.derc.gov.in). Copy of the Draft Regulations and Staff paper would be available for sale at Commission's office on any working day till 29.03.2012 between 11:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. by making payment of Rs. 20/- for Draft DERC (Terms & Conditions For Determination Of Tariff For Procurement Of Power From Grid-Connected Solar Photo Voltic Power Projects) and Rs. 50/- for Draft DERC (DSM Implementation Framework) Regulations, 2012 respectively either by cash/Demand Draft/Pay Order in favour of Secretary, DERC payable at New Delhi.

3. All the stakeholders are requested to forward their comments/objections on the draft regulations to the Secretary of the Commission, latest by 30.03.2012, either personally or by post or through e-mail to secyderc@nic.in.
  
4. The Commission shall hold a public hearing before finalization of the Regulations. The Stakeholders shall be informed about the date of public hearing through Public Notice in the newspapers.
