**INTERIM ORDER**

1. The instant petition has been filed by Shri Charan Singh Maan, under Section 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003 against BSES Rajdhani Power Ltd. for violation of the procedure as laid down in Regulations of the Delhi Electricity Regulatory Supply Code and Performance Standards Regulations, 2007.

2. The matter was listed for hearing in the Commission, which was attended by both the parties. During the hearing, the Petitioner urged for a copy of the reply as he had not received the same. Accordingly, it was served upon him at the time of hearing. The Petitioner submitted that all the points raised in the reply have already been rebutted in the rejoinder dated 10.12.2015 filed by him and he is ready for arguments. The Counsel for the Respondent submitted that he is not in the possession of rejoinder and sought for a copy of it, which was provided to him.
3. The Respondent sought adjournment of the matter stating that he requires one weeks time to prepare for the arguments on the points of rejoinder.
4. The Commission accepted the prayer of the Respondent and adjourned the matter.
5. The next date of hearing shall be intimated to the parties in due course.
