INTERIM ORDER

1. The instant petition has been filed by Shri Dhanish Goyal under Section 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003 against BSES Rajdhani Power Ltd. for violation of the procedure as laid down in the Regulations of the Delhi Electricity Supply Code and Performance Standards Regulations, 2007.
2. The counsel for the Petitioner submitted that vide the Interim Order dated 26.07.2016, the parties were directed to file their respective written submissions on the status of settlement so as to determine maintainability of the Petition, the same has been filed by the Petitioner, however, the Respondent has failed to comply with the Order of the Commission. It was further submitted that in compliance to the Interim Order dated 24.04.2017 of

the Commission, the Petitioner has also submitted the amended prayer clause of the Petition through the same written submissions.

3. The counsel for the Respondent requested for a short adjournment stating the ground that the judgement of the Special Court of Electricity on the same matter is in final stage and is likely to be concluded within a week. Any deliberation by the Commission on the same may have an impact on the ongoing case in the Special Court of Electricity.
4. The matter was adjourned with a direction to the Respondent to file its written submission in compliance to the Commission's Interim Order dated 26.07.2016 within a weeks time with a copy to the Petitioner.
5. The next date of hearing shall be intimated to the parties in due course.
6. Ordered accordingly.
