ORDER

(Date of Hearing: 17.10.2017)

1. The instant petition filed by the Petitioner is for determination of tariff in respect of surplus power from Grid interactive Solar Photovoltaic Power Plant of Petitioner established at Indira Paryavaran Bhawan, Jorbagh Aliganj, New Delhi.
2. The Petitioner, *vide* interim order dated 25.11.2014, was directed to enter into a fresh connection agreement with NDMC as per the provisions specified under the DERC (Net Metering for Renewable Energy) Regulations 2014 notified on 25th

September, 2014. Accordingly, it was also decided that the tariff should be determined only for the period from November, 2013 till 24.09.2014.

3. The representative of the Petitioner submitted that as per the directions of the Commission the Petitioner had applied for net metering connection and in the month of August, 2016 net meters have been installed in its aforesaid establishment, however, one of the meters is not giving correct reading. It was further submitted by the Petitioner that as of now its consumption is more than the production through its Solar Photovoltaic Power Plant and therefore, it is proposed that the surplus energy generated since establishment of plant till date may also be "set off" on net metering basis against the future consumption.
4. As the Petitioner is not seeking determination of tariff and is agreeable to the concept of set off applying the provisions of the Net Metering Regulations, the parties are directed to sort out the matter through discussions so as to reach an agreement in respect of supply on net metering basis.
5. With the above directions the matter is disposed off. The Petitioner is granted liberty to approach this Commission if need arises.
6. Ordered accordingly.
