**ORDER**

(Date of Order: 30.06.2017)

1. M/S BSES Yamuna Power limited (BYPL or DISCOM) has submitted the present Petition for implementation of Energy Efficient Fans Programme (EEFP) for Fans in household sector and commercial sector in Delhi under Demand Side Management (DSM) Programme.
2. The proposal as contained in the Petition was that the capital investment required for implementation of the Programme will be made through an Energy Service Company viz. M/s Energy Efficiency Services Limited (EESL), New Delhi and BYPL shall make payment to EESL by recovering the cost from consumers in 24 monthly instalments.
3. The Commission *Vide* Interim Order dated 28.04.2017 has enquired from the Petitioner whether the instant Programme is in variance to or in line with the similar DSM Programme for efficient lighting project for LED Bulbs in Delhi and would it be appropriate to approve the instant Programme on the similar lines. In response the Petitioner has submitted that the initial agreement dated 21.05.2015 made by BYPL with Energy Efficiency Services Ltd. (EESL) for "Domestic Efficient Lightening Programme" (DELP) for distribution of LED bulbs has since been revised as Pradhan Mantri UJALA Yojna by MoP and energy efficient fans have also been included in the Programme. Accordingly, following amendments have

been made in the existing agreement dated 21.05.2015 under DELP entered into by BYPL and EESL:

- a. The Project shall be known as the "Unnat Jeevan by Affordable LEDs and Appliances to All" (UJALA programme);
  - b. EESL shall be responsible for overall implementation of UJALA-Programme that includes 7 W LED Bulb, 9W LED Bulb, 20 W LED Tube lights, BEE 5 star rated Fans in the operation area of DISCOM;
  - c. The distribution of LED Bulb, LED Tube lights & BEE 5 star rated Fans will be under Upfront mode only;
  - d. BEE 5 star rated Fan shall be at Rs. 1150 per fan on Upfront Payment mode. EESL has full right to amend the prices of products;
  - e. The distribution of 9 W LED bulb, 20 W LED Tube light and BEE 5 star rated Fan will start w.e.f. 1<sup>st</sup> Feb 2017 till 31<sup>st</sup> December 2017;
  - f. An amount of INR 4 per CA No. for each product separately can be made available to each of the DISCOM as charges for availing their respective support services during the distribution; and
  - g. As a promotional activity, Rs. 1 per CA No. shall be offered for advertisement done through monthly bill. For promotion done through SMS/email, Rs. 0.10 shall be offered per CA No. Design, Size & Duration of promotional activities shall be decided by EESL & DISCOM mutually.
4. The abovementioned amendments were intimated to the Commission by BYPL vide their letter dated 09.12.2016 and the Commission in its reply dated 16.01.2017 had directed that *".....the DISCOMs may take up the DSM Schemes expeditiously either on their own or through an aggregator mutually agreed amongst them, in order to get the volume and cost advantage in implementation of such DSM Schemes. Any expenses/income incurred on account of implementation of UJALA scheme will not be pass through in Aggregate Revenue Requirement (ARR)."*

5. Considering the submissions made by the Petitioner, the Commission approves this Programme as under:

**i. Discounted Price:**

The BEE 5 Star rated fans will be made available at a price of Rs. 1150 per fan under upfront payment mode.

**ii. Expenses in ARR:**

Any expenses/income incurred on account of implementation of UJALA Programme will not be pass through in Annual Revenue Requirement.

**iii. Eligibility of Consumers:**

- a. The consumer should have a valid consumer connection number/CA number.
- b. There shall be no outstanding dues as on date of application.
- c. A maximum number of 3 Fans shall be offered to a consumer.
- d. The Programme shall be applicable on first come first serve basis for the eligible consumers.

**iv. Implementing Agency:**

EESL shall be responsible for overall implementation of UJALA-Program for BEE 5 star rated Fans in the operation area of DISCOM.

**v. Validity of the Programme:**

The Programme shall be valid upto 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2017. The Commission may consider extension of the date of instant Programme on a request made by the DISCOM.

6. The Petition is accordingly disposed of.
