INTERIM ORDER

(Date of Hearing: 13.04.2017)

(Date of Order: 24.04.2017)

1. The instant petition has been filed by Sh. Rakesh Kumar Pathak under Section 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003 against North Delhi Municipal Corporation (NDMC) for violation of the procedure as laid down in the Regulations of the Delhi Electricity Supply Code and Performance Standards Regulations, 2007.
2. The matter was listed for hearing in the Commission, which was attended by both the parties. During the hearing, the Petitioner submitted that he has

complied with all the provisions of Delhi Electricity Supply Code and Performance Standards Regulation, 2007, regarding transfer of name in the case of legal heir and he has also provided a copy of Will as a document supporting his legal heirship. He further submitted that he is a bonafide tenant of AICC to which this property belongs.

3. The Representative of the Respondent, NDMC stated that the premises under question is an evacuee property, which at present is administered and managed by the Land and Building Department, Govt. of NCT of Delhi. He further submitted that vide letter no. D/1303/EE(C) dated 22.11.2016, a reference has been made to the Land and Building Department, Govt. of NCT of Delhi about the status of the property in question. However, no response has been received from the Govt. of NCT of Delhi in this regard so far.
4. The Commission observed that Land and Building Department, Govt. of NCT of Delhi may also be heard in the matter and accordingly directed that notice be issued to the Land and Building Department, Govt. of NCT of Delhi. The matter was adjourned.
5. The next date of hearing shall be intimated to the parties in due course.
6. Ordered accordingly.
