**ORDER**

1. The instant petition has been filed by Shri Dhanish Goyal under Section 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003 against BSES Rajdhani Power Ltd. for violation of the procedure as laid down in the Regulations of the Delhi Electricity Supply Code and Performance Standards Regulations, 2007.
2. On the date of last hearing i.e. on 25.10.2017, the matter was adjourned at the request of the Respondent on the ground that the theft case on the same matter is in final stage in the Special Court of Electricity and is likely to be concluded within a week.

3. The Counsel for the Respondent handed over a copy of the judgment dated 31.10.2014 of the Special Court of Electricity in the theft case filed against the Petitioner and submitted that the case has been decided against the Petitioner.
4. The Counsel for the Petitioner submitted that he wants to settle the matter with the Respondent and requested for a short adjournment.
5. As a settlement is a matter between two parties, which does not require intervention of the Commission, no further deliberations are required in instant case, hence the Petition is dismissed
6. Ordered accordingly.
