ORDER

(Date of Order: 04.07.2018)

1. M/s Tata Power Delhi Distribution Limited (TPDDL) has submitted the present petition for approval of the Commission for the Automated Demand Response Scheme (ADR Scheme) under Demand Side Management (DSM) with following prayers:
 - a) To grant in principle approval for the scheme proposed by the petitioner subject to any suitable modifications as may be modified by the Hon'ble Commission; and/or
 - b) To allow the related expenses of operational and capital expenditure incurred in conceiving and execution of the proposed project in addition to the ARR of the petitioner.
2. The petition was admitted *vide* order dated 22.06.2015.
3. The Commission has granted in-principle approval of the ADR Scheme under DSM to the Petitioner *vide* letter dated 09.02.2016 for two years subject to the following conditions:
 - i. The pilot scheme may be continued for two years without any Capex;
 - ii. The petitioner shall enter into an agreement with the consumers;
 - iii. The benefit accruing from the scheme shall be reviewed on a quarterly basis. After two years, the Commission will take an overall view on whether the scheme should be extended and the terms and conditions of such extension if so decided; and

- iv. Relevant records for expenditure/receipt shall be maintained separately.
4. It is observed that the period of two years from the date of in-principle approval has expired in the month of February 2018 and the Petitioner has failed, even after reminder, to submit any report or material before the Commission for consideration for further extension to the scheme.
5. In view of the above, no extension to the scheme is granted and the petition is disposed of.
